Team in Training Makes Huge Impact in the Lives of those less fortunate than us.



For many of us in the Club, bet you knew little about what the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society was, or what they actually do. The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) is the world's largest voluntary health agency dedicated to blood cancer. The LLS mission: Cure leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease and myeloma, and improve the quality of life of patients and their families. LLS funds lifesaving blood cancer research around the world and provides free information and support.

Stacey Duncan of the LLS was our guest speaker last week. So here is where the Team in Training steps in. They are the mainstay of the LLS. Their funding has raised over \$1 Billion since 1988. And most of their dollars stay here locally. Missouri has 3 to 5 researchers working on new cures for the diseases at the Stowers Institute. And the LLS also has lots of resources for those that have been diagnosed with leukemia or lymphoma, and lends support for their families as well.

Team in Training is currently recruiting for their summer season for 2014. They have lots of beginner and intermediate programs available to join. Most center around biking and / or a triathlon, but walking is there for those not as athletically inclined. Wherever the Team in Training participates, you will find that they are one of the happiest groups out there! The Team in Training will teach you how to fundraise, and lend you support to do so. When you sign up to participate, you will find that some of your costs to be a part of these events will be covered by LLS. Team in Training has set what they feel are reachable goals – to raise from \$500 to \$2000 for local events, and if you are traveling away to a larger regional or national event, then \$3000 to \$5000 would drive lots towards their cause.
