People don't realize that filters are what keeps your system running, and your air clean and free of particulates. Mike says you need to get a higher rated filter and showed several choices, from the \$2 "football" filter (because all it catches is a football!) to filters with angled baffles, and the top of the line hospital-grade filters that remove up to 95% of particles and other bacteria and viruses in the air. Costs for these range from just a few bucks to as much as \$150-\$175.

Well, no more space heaters or fans. Now Mitsubishi Electric has developed a great new wall unit that sits up near the ceiling and via a remote control sends out signals to raise or lower the temperature of a room, all done with outside venting and draining. These have been very popular in Europe and are now making their introduction here. They circulate the air very well and are very efficient and quiet.

The third thing that really amazed most at breakfast was the electronic dampers that open and close once one area reached a designated temperature, and sends heated or

cooled air say upstairs to an area that does not get the air it needs except by the hot air rising and the cold air falling. This way you can regulate temps better.
