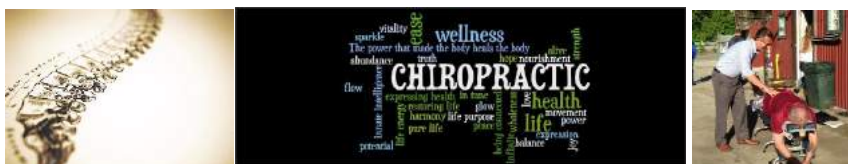


## PROSPECTORS BREAKFAST CLUB
