More light on the building at night, making the Clinic feel so homely and comfortable when his patients and their owners need his services.

Plaza Animal Clinic is a full line facility serving the local pet population in the central city area, but expands into Mission Hills, South KC, and JoCo for those that drive to see Bradlee.

They do routine exams, vaccinations, and treat you pet if they had an accident or is injured. They specialize in taking care of any animal emergency that arises, and that happens more than you think.

For more complex issues – broken bones, digestive issues, or cancers, then surgeries are in order, and Brad is skilled there having performed hundreds of different procedures. They deal with everthing from cosmetic repairs, broken legs, to swallowing objects like stuffed animals. No situation is too small.

With help from his new staff and his mentors, he has reorganized the way business was done at the Clinic. And the internet has changed how he dispenses his treatments to his pet friends. Brad warned us to be cautious in buying pet pharmacy products online, as only about 12% of them follow federal and state guidelines.

If you have a pet, or know someone that does, please keep Bradlee Twigg and his fantastic crew in mind for special care and concern when it comes to your pet's health. Thank you Brad for all you do to make our world so much better.






