"Housework Can't Kill You, But Why Take A Chance" - Phyllis Diller

They are a tight knit crew, and were there for each other when their mother succumbed to cancer several years ago. Dan was a bit of an adventurer in his younger years, taking his love of music and learning to play the drums where he felt very comfortable and fortunate to play in local bands for many of his younger years, and still carries on even today. He has even worked on the pit crew of stock car racing teams, and loved doing it.

when it comes to food. So much so, he has taken and graduated from the JoCo Culinary Institute, a 3 year commitment. He now has a commercial grade stove and oven in his home with all the bells, whistles, and gadgets to go with it. He says what he learned from it is invaluable in making sure he eats nothing but the best foods he can get his hands on. It is great when you can do something that you love to do and share it with others.

Dan's father was the impetus for him getting into the carpet business. You see, his Dad was known throughout the carpet industry and the "Godfather of Carpet". When he would go to trade shows or conventions in Las Vegas, his Dad had concocted special chemical treatments that would help clean as well as remove many types of stains. Those in the know would find him, buy his products, and learn from him techniques that he perfected. It is hard to get really dirty carpets clean without streaking. Some of the worst is, of course, rental carpets.

Dan says YES you CAN clean rentals carpeting. It is best to try and save them rather than replacing. You can use them for a longer time. But you've got to know what you're doing to get the desired results.

Dan has since found what he names the Roto-Vac, a carpet cleaning tool that saves him time in scrubbing carpets faster and with less energy. Dan says he can come and clean them in-house, but he would only be able to do the top of it. But – if he takes it off site, then he can clean the front, back and the fringe if there is any, making for a much better process.
